As you are reading this newsletter we are back in Romania after the visit in the United States with Cristina and our two youngest sons Daniel and Timotei. The Lord answered the prayers of our youngest children as every time I came to the states, especially the youngest one, Timotei would preciously ask if I could put him in the suitcase and take him with me. Each time I would tell him to pray that the Lord would make a way. **They took this instruction seriously and the Lord opened the opportunity for us all to come to the U.S.** We are so very thankful for the family who purchased the tickets for us all to travel and be here together. We also want to say "Thank You" to all of you who were part of this year's banquet and all of those out of town guests who traveled to be with us. It was a great honor to spend time with all of you who made this event to be special for the glory and honor of the Lord. We appreciate your continued support, love and prayers for the work of the ministry in Eastern Europe and beyond.

During our stay in the United States, the Lord opened wonderful opportunities to speak at various events. One was a summer camp for the young people 18 years old and up in Michigan where over 100 youth and young adults were able to be reached as well as challenge them with the theme "Men and Women of the Kingdom".



We were very blessed to see them responding to the call of God and taking seriously the things of the Kingdom of God and the soon coming of the Lord Jesus Christ.



As we traveled and ministered along side our friend and Pastor Lonnie Jarvis, he was sharing the opportunity and preparing to go to Peru for the crusade, evangelistic meetings and pastor conferences. Cristina was praying that the Lord would open the opportunity to go with them and take the children to go to Peru. The Lord worked in a wonderful marvelous way and opened the door so we were able to travel with them.



Hundreds and hundreds of people came to receive the Lord Jesus Christ, repented of their sins and made the decision to follow the Lord Jesus, from young to old. It is wonderful that so many precious people traveled knowing that it is winter in South America. We went from 100 degrees in the southern US to 50 in the most



southern point of Peru in the city of Tacna. It was an honor and blessing to look at the joy of the people receiving the Lord Jesus Christ seeing the wonderful response after they repented and to see the change in their countenance even in the oldest people. Please pray along with us that the Lord would continue to make a difference in the lives of these converts who will be discipled by the local churches. During the mornings I had the privilege to also minister to pastors, their wives and leaders of the local churches along side Pastor

Lonnie Jarvis, sharing the message of encouraging them and the importance of paying the price of serving.



It is one of the greatest blessings to see them moving forward in Jesus Christ. **One of the greatest challenges that we have found in every nation we have traveled to is that the harvest is truly plentiful but the laborers are few, Matthew 9:37.** Please continue to pray that the Lord would entrust laborers into his Harvest field.

We are so very appreciative of your hearts for the needs here in Eastern Europe. Please pray along with us for the widows and that the Lord would provide for all of them.



You can see Sister Ana and Nadia above with the large pile of wood that we have been able to bless them with in the past. Some have come forward this year to help us meet this growing need and to help us to make a difference in the lives of these precious people here that are forgotten in Eastern Europe. **Still there is a need to help the rest of the widows (\$600 each) for purchasing wood and coal to last the winter.** The national missionaries in whom we work directly with now say there are at least 15 widows in total.

As we look ahead and you begin to make preparations for the Christmas season and the children in the states, would you please consider praying and helping us to make a difference this year in the lives of the children in orphanages by providing them with a pair of winter shoes that we

receive at cost directly from the manufacturer (\$30 each pair).



It's such a great joy and blessing to be able to bless the children in the Cornesti orphanage and families with many children. We are so honored to be able to continue to make a difference in their lives.



At the same time we want to thank you for continuing to provide bibles for those who have accepted the Lord. There is nothing greater than to be able to put God's Word in their hands. We continually pray for provision of bibles (\$8 each) that we purchase from the Republic of Moldova.



Words cannot express how very thankful we are for every family who welcomed us in their homes, every church in which we had meetings with leaders during our time in the states, those who took care of us with meals and welcoming us as a family with our children, so they could finally meet our partners and friends that we pray for continually while we are in Romania.

We are greatly honored and appreciate our friends and partners who continue to come along side us whether prayerfully, financially or on the mission field. Your kindness and generosity does not go unnoticed and we pray that the Lord Jesus Christ will return to you a hundredfold that which you sow into His Kingdom! May the Lord Jesus bless all of you abundantly in Him.
