Greetings in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ:

After a brief two weeks back in Romania, I have returned to the United States for the fall mission conferences and to visit old as well as new friends. I am so very thankful to all of you who open your homes up to me with such wonderful hospitality during these times of travel as well as all of you who continue to pray and support what the Lord is doing in Eastern Europe through our working together for Kingdom advancement.

Fall has arrived, which brings a sense of urgency for those who are in need because of the harsh winters that we experience in that part of the world. Many of you know that each year we pray for the Lord to provide sufficient wood and coal for the widows of Moldova **who must exist on only \$45 per month assistance from the government.**



Our dear sister Ana (above) recently told me that she had prayed to the Lord, thanking Him for provision in the past and that if He would provide for one more winter, then she knew she would live another year. If not, then she believed He would take her home to be with Him. Many of you have so generously given through the years and we are so very thankful for your faithfulness and heart for these precious elderly saints who live day to day dependent on the Lord Jesus Christ to provide. As the bible says in James 1:27, **“Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress...”**. One of the national missionaries shared with us that more widows and elderly have come forward asking for assistance of wood and coal, so that they can heat their homes and cook

on their stoves. We pray with the Lord’s help each year to provide sufficient funds to purchase the wood at the cheapest time of the year and have been able to purchase for a few this year.



Still, there is a need to provide for all those who are seeking help, which is \$600 per household. Please pray along with us that the Lord would provide the funds to purchase these vital materials to keep them warm as they all continue to pray with thankfulness for our friends and partners.

Since the fall of communism, the elderly in Eastern Europe have become so very vulnerable due mostly because of their families leaving them behind to seek work in other countries. Government assistance is no more than the price of a couple eating in a restaurant one time here in the United States. They depend on neighbors who have no more than they do because of rampant poverty.



As many of you know, we were introduced to Adina a few months ago who lived in extremely poor conditions (above). She was the first Christian believer in her area. **The Lord spoke to the hearts of our partners who stepped forward and provided for her to have a new home.** We are so very thankful to all of you who have made

this become a reality to help improve her living conditions from what you see below.



We are so very thankful to the Lord that our years of relationship and network building are coming to fruition in a beautiful way. National missionaries and dear brothers Vitale and Sashe have sacrificially taken the time to travel from Moldova to reach out to those who are hurting in Romania and have helped to build her new home.



They recently brought their families to help paint the house, which was such a precious time of fellowship. Now, as we are beginning to work on the inside, ***we ask that you pray along with us that the Lord would provide the materials to build her a new stove (\$1500)*** which would also keep her warm in the winter, much like the one pictured right (above) that we were able to build for



another dear Sister, Nina. It is also our heart's desire to provide her with a few furnishings such as a bed and table as she has very little. Please continue to pray that we can see this project to completion with the Lord's help.

Another vital project that we pray to continue with the help of the Lord Jesus Christ is to provide winter boots and shoes for the orphans, the elderly and those who have large families and are in need.



Thousands have received new winter boots throughout the years with the help of our friends and partners and we are asking that you pray along with us that the Lord would provide so that families will not have to share their shoes in order



to take turns to walk to church or so that the orphans are able to get out and play in the snow and colder conditions. They are always so very thankful to all of you for helping them to be warm in the winter months. As most of you know we receive

these from a dear brother in Moldova who owns a shoe manufacturing company and provides us the boots at cost (\$35 per pair) for wonderful quality wool lined boots.

We are so humbled and thankful that you all continue to allow us to be your hands and feet on the mission field as we share each month the wonderful things the Lord is doing through the team of national missionaries and because of your faithful prayers and support. May the Lord Jesus Christ find us all continuing to do His will upon His soon return as we pray for you and your families daily. We love and appreciate all of you!
